





About Jesse Kelly

Born in the Ohio Rust Belt, Jesse Kelly joined the U.S. Marine Corps in 2000 and on 9/11, watched the towers fall from inside his barracks. He later deployed to Iraq as an infantry Marine during the Second Persian Gulf War and received an honorable discharge after four years. In 2010, with no political experience to speak of but many opinions to share, Kelly ran for Congress in a Democratic-controlled district of Arizona. Though a virtual unknown in the race, he was only narrowly defeated by Rep. Gabrielle Giffords. The race initially ended in a vote recount. After his Congressional run, Kelly continued to be a major voice among conservatives, using his large social media following as a platform to continue many of the conversations started on the campaign trail. He signed on to host a one-hour show on 950 KPRC in Houston, Texas, in 2018, which was expanded to a two-hour program. "The Jesse Kelly Show" debuted as a three-hour program in national syndication in April 2020. Fans can follow Kelly on Facebook, Twitter and Instagram. Dickey Broadcasting launches conservative talk station Xtra 106.3/AM1230 with Rush Limbaugh, Glenn Beck, Mark Zinno

The station will keep the programming that replaces Rush's show and use Fox News Dickey Broadcasting has launched a new conservative talk station on its Xtra 106.3 FM signal and AM1230 signal anchored by the current Rush Limbaugh show which is using

guest hosts and "best of" moments from the late host's past. Limbaugh died of lung cancer in February at age 70. David Dickey, Xtra owner, said in an interview Tuesday with The Atlanta Journal-Constitution that as soon as he heard news/talk 95.5/750 WSB chose to drop Limbaugh's show after his death, Dickey decided to change Xtra's format from sports to news/talk. For many years, Dickey had broadcast ESPN sports programming on the signal, then local sports for four years until last fall, designing Xtra like a minor-league training ground for his primary sports talk station 93.7/680 The Fan. The pandemic forced him to cut costs; so last fall, he let go two of his highest-paid talkers

Steak Shapiro and John Kincaid and moved Xtra 106.3's "Hometown" Brandon Leak and Joe Hamilton to the Fan.He said he signed a four-year agreement with Limbaugh's syndication company Premiere Networks that requires them to keep Limbaugh and whatever show the syndicator ultimately chooses to replace him on Xtra 106.3. The show now airs on Xtra in Limbaugh's usual slot of noon to 3 p.m. In Atlanta, Limbaugh aired for more than two decades on 640/WGST, then moved to WSB in 2012, where he stayed until he died of cancer. WSB last month moved Erick Erickson to the noon to 3 p.m. slot.

Dickey has also committed to Glenn Beck from 9 a.m. to noon, Guy Benson from 3 to 6 p.m., Buck Sexton from 6 p.m. to midnight and George Noory overnights. (The Limbaugh show will repeat from 9 p.m. to midnight.)

For news updates, Xtra 106.3 will use Fox News and Dickey plans to fashion a live and local morning show. For now, he is using former Mark Zinno on Mondays with plans to hire an entire morning show around Zinno. The other mornings, for now, will feature a Fox News radio show.

Zinno had been let go from Xtra last fall during Dickey's cost-cutting moves, and as an Army veteran, has been working on the COVID-19 task force for the National Guard. "I'm excited to be back and excited to work with David again," Zinno said. "There was never any acrimony between him and me. I'm glad he thinks highly enough of me to look at me to lead this venture."

Dickey said he loves Kim "The Kimmer" Peterson, who lost his last on-air job at Talk 106.7, which Atlanta-based Cumulus Media sold to an outfit that now plays Christian contemporary music. But he decided to go a different route.

Dickey Broadcasting officials said the station will broadcast programs that include "The Rush Limbaugh Show," "The Glenn Beck Program," "Guy Benson," "The Buck Sexton Show," and "Coast to Coast AM with George Noory."

"We are excited to announce the return of Rush Limbaugh, Glenn Beck and Fox News, among many other great names, to the Atlanta market," David Dickey, president of Dickey Broadcasting Company said in a press release. "These voices have entertained and informed generations of Atlantans, and will now continue to do so on XTRA 106.3FM and streaming on the XTRA app.

"Atlantans deserve great options for their news and information. We are proud that we can deliver this popular content to millions of listeners who feel they've been disenfranchised by recent programming shifts."

Beck and Fox News had previously been used by IHeartMedia's news/talk 640/WGST-AM, which switched to a Black Information Network format last year
