The Bakersfield Police Department is seeking the community's assistance in identifying and locating the following suspect wanted for Robbery. On July 16, 2015, at 11:00 pm, the suspect entered the Taco Bell restaurant located at 3300 Panama Ln., went around the counter to the drive-thru window, threatened the cashier and took cash from the register before fleeing on foot. The suspect is described as a:

hispanic male, 30, 5'7", 170-200 lbs., brown hair, wearing a dark knit cap, grey long-sleeved t-shirt and black shorts.
