The Bakersfield Police Department is seeking the community's assistance in identifying and locating the following suspect wanted for Hit and Run causing injury. On Monday, December 7th, 2015, at 10:50 pm, officers responded to the 3000 block of Q Street regarding an injury hit and run traffic collision, involving a bicyclist and a vehicle. The driver of the vehicle fled the scene prior to police arrival.

The involved vehicle was described as an:

**2005 to 2014 model Ford Mustang
Light blue in color
With tinted windows**

The possible driver of the vehicle was described as a:

**Black Male Adult, 20 to 30 years old
Short black hair, thin build
Wearing a gray hooded sweatshirt and red shorts**
