All hiring managers—Market Manager, Operations Manager, and Hiring Managers—as well as the entire staff were required to complete a series of sessions prepared by the Health & Safety Institute (HIS) entitled, Understanding Harassment and Anti-Harassment — Managers (6 sessions for staff and 9 for managers). The sessions explained what harassment is, provided tips to help understand offenders and targets; offered bystander training; described warning signs, and instructed viewers about how to create a healthy workplace culture. There was additional training for managers about supervisory responsibilities and how to conduct investigations regarding claims of harassment. In order to obtain a certificate of participation, all employees were required to take a quiz following their completion of each session.
2	Management-level training regarding Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion	During the months of March and April of 2023, this SEU participated in additional Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion training. All hiring managers—Market Manager, Operations Manager, and Hiring Managers—as well as the entire staff were required to complete the Health & Safety Institute (HSI) on-line course presented in two segments entitled, <i>Microaggressions</i> and <i>Tokenism</i> . The segments defined these terms, explained how they originated, and provided methods to overcome these behaviors.
